

Integrity: I will be honest with my words and my actions!

Have each family member repeat the Main Point over and over for one minute each. See who can say the Main Point the most times in a minute while still being understood.

Bible Verse: "People with integrity walk safely, but those who follow crooked paths will slip and fall." Proverbs 10:9 NLT

Read the Bible Story together: David faces Goliath.
(1 Samuel 17)

Ask your child if they've ever had a time when they didn't want to do something they said they would do. How did they handle that situation?

Honesty Counts

Integrity means you will do what you say you will do. When you tell somebody you will do something, even though it's not always the easiest decision, you should do it. Tell your child of a time when you told someone you would do something but then didn't follow through. What happened because you made that decision? Discuss with your child something they have to do in the next week. Write it down on a piece of paper. Working together, think of each step that has to take place in order for them to have integrity in the situation and write it down on the paper. Encourage your child to always choose to have integrity and follow through with what they say they are going to do.

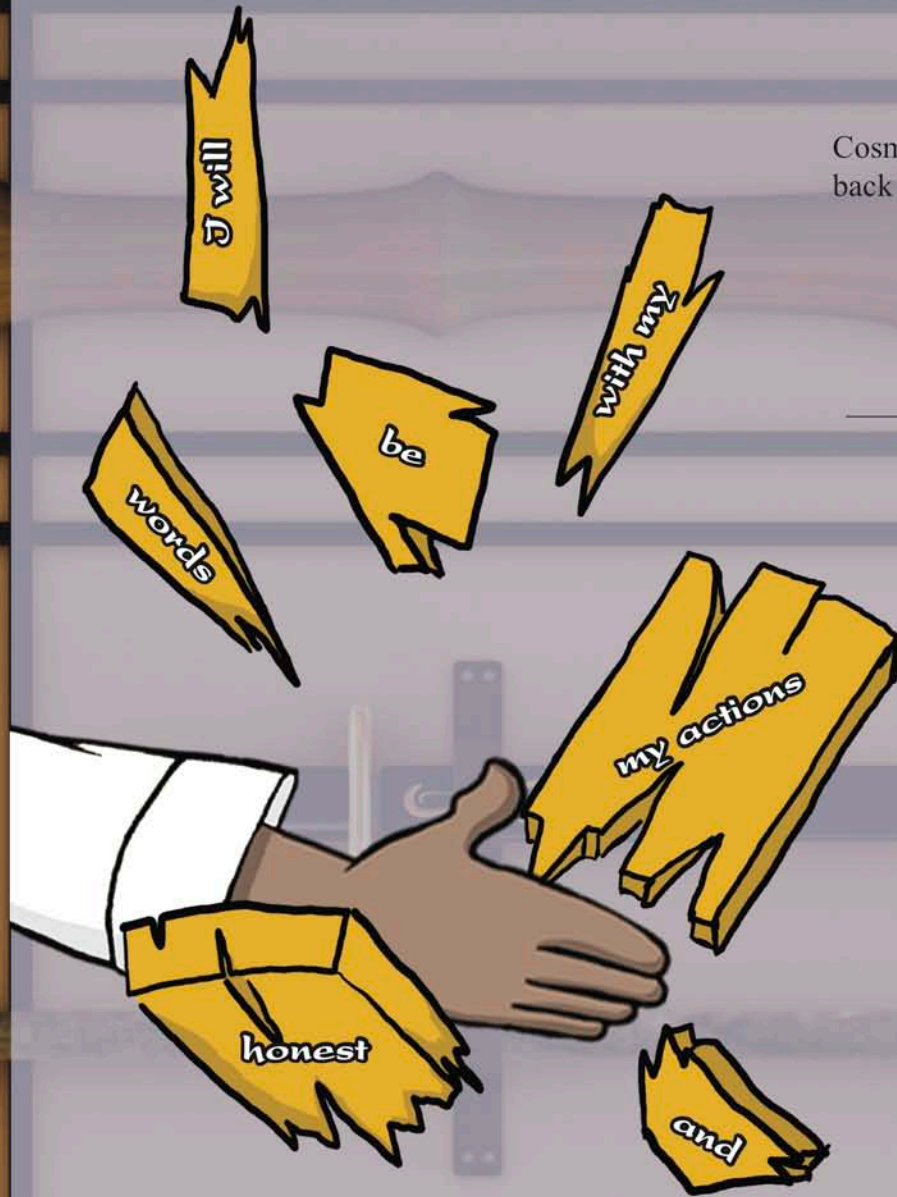
