FAMILY ACTIVITY

Lesson 1: I Will Wait!

Today, your child learned about waiting. They learned how important it is to have patience. This week, play a game called "Wait and Go" as a family. Have the family line up on one side of a room or on one side of your backyard. The Leader should stand in the middle of the area. When the leader says Go, everyone should start running to the opposite side. When the leader says Wait, the runners should stop and wait. The winner is the person who goes to the opposite side and back to the leader in the middle first! Encourage your child by talking about what it feels like to have to wait and how that helps us have patience.
